## International Exchange Program

- Established in 1962.
- Total number of registered students reached 25,186 in the year of 2019.
- Number of partner universities world: 414 (By 09/2020)
- The study fields of CCU stretches from Liberal Arts to Agriculture in 13 colleges with 64 departments this year.

### WHO MAY APPLY

- Currently registered undergraduates in home (partner) university.
- Nominated by program coordinators
- Ensued by online application fill-out
- May apply as visiting students at their own costs if from non-partner university.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Choose from Mandarin-taught or English-taught programs.
- Participate in dozens of free Mandarin language courses and Chinese cultural courses with credits for a taste of the cultural beauty.
- Acquire academic knowledge about global business when enrolled in English-taught program (bachelor and master provided).
- Students in English-taught program are welcome to select Mandarin courses as well.
- Options of one semester or two semesters (= one academic year) are available to choose.

- Note: Fall semester refers to the first semester of the academic year whereas spring semester refers to the second semester.

### WHEN TO APPLY

**Nomination, Application and deadlines:** Incoming candidates have to be nominated by email to [exchange@ulive.pccu.edu.tw](mailto:exchange@ulive.pccu.edu.tw) with full name, email, field of study, and duration of stay. All candidates must fill out CCU online application to complete the application.

#### Nomination deadlines:

- Fall semester: November 15th, 2020
- Spring semester: May 15th, 2021

#### Application deadlines

- Fall semester: November 30, 2020
- Spring semester: May 31, 2021

### VISA & ARC

- One-semester students may only apply for short-term visiting student visa before entering Taiwan. The visa may be extended within 15 days before its expiry date.
- Academic year students are allowed to enter Taiwan with an exchange student visa that bears the name of CCU. After arrival, they are then required to apply for Alien Residence Certificate (ARC) at local service centers of the National Immigration Agency within 15 days starting from the next day of their arrival in Taiwan. They may stay in Taiwan (R.O.C.) as long as the ARC card is valid.

### ON CAMPUS DORMITORIES

- Non-coed, furnished but WITHOUT mattress and bedding. Provide ordering service.
- Laundry facilities included.
- No cooking throughout stay.
- Open for applying in summer and winter breaks.
- Three in one room for gentlemen while six in one room for ladies.
- Fees range around US 370-530 per semester.
