- Outstanding facilities. DUELI students have access to the same facilities as Deakin students. DUELI
 facilities also include Independent on line learning hubs, designed specifically to enable
 conversation, listening and video areas, with self-study areas.
- Small classes enhance the learning experience. DUELI's classes range from 8 to 15 students, with classes designed to help students make the most of their time while learning in a friendly, welcoming and multicultural environment.
- Providing a pathway entry to Deakin University. Since 2005, more than 10000 students have articulated to an award course program at Deakin University and more than 5000 have articulated to a Diploma pathway at Deakin College after successfully completing a DUELI pathway program.
- A unique DUELI Leaders Internship program. DUELI has developed its own programs where participants have the opportunity to develop leadership skills and make valuable contributions to the international student community.
